EntropySoft's IBM WebSphere PDM software connector enables read-only access to content stored in the IBM WebSphere PDM repository. IBM WebSphere PDM is based on a Java Content Repository (JCR) and stores content in a relational database management system (RDBMS).

Says Nicolas Maquaire, EntropySoft CEO, "Specially designed for versions 5.1 and 6.0 of IBM WebSphere PDM, our connector uses specific APIs to be able to access document permissions as well as navigate in the user-directory. This is a very useful feature for our OEM partners and their customers. By releasing this connector, we are aiming to further consolidate our market-leading position. Our connectors and products portfolio will also help IBM customers achieve smooth content transfers between the IBM WebSphere PDM repository and other repositories."
