- Content Hub that acts as a single access point to all connected content silos. In-house applications can access Content Hub with a web-services API. Content Hub is also compliant with the latest interoperability standard, CMIS.
- Content ETL to manage all transfers to and from on-premises or cloud repositories. Documents with metadata and permissions can be taken from any content repository and transferred to any other content repository, whether on-premises or in the cloud.

EntropySoft designed the appliance to host different document services: the first service to be included is content sharing, Additional services will be gradually added to the appliance.
